sequence 1: presentation

location: streets of bogotá and lucia's front yard.

BEFORE BATHING HIM, YOU NEED TO TIE HIM SO HE DOES NOT ESCAPE. YOU WILL NEED SHAMPOO, A TOWEL, A BRUSH AND DOG LOTION.

sequence 2: my dog's story

lucia's drawings

lucia tells us how her parents gave her the dog. her drawings illustrate her story.

LUCÍA VOICE OFF: 58:09
MY DOG'S NAME SAMUEL. I WAS AT MY GRANDMOTHER LULU'S HOUSE AND MY FATHER CAME TO PICK ME UP, BUT WITHOUT SAMUEL BECAUSE HE WAS IN MY ROOM. I SAID HI TO MY MOTHER "HI MOM" AND I WENT TO MY ROOM AND WAS VERY SURPRISED BECAUSE THERE WAS A DOG INSIDE. SO I ASKED MY MOTHER "MOM, IS THAT DOG GOING TO STAY WITH US?" "OF COURSE, BECAUSE HE'S YOUR DOG".

Sequence 3: Washing the dog.

Location: Lucia's front yard

Lucia starts to bathe her dog, and explains what she's doing

step by step.

LUCÍA VOICE OFF: **1:28:20**
SOMETHING ELSE YOU HAVE TO DO BEFORE YOU BATHE YOUR DOG... ITS NOT ABOUT THE DOG. YOU HAVE TO WEAR CLOTHES THAT YOU DON'T USUALLY WEAR, CLOTHES THAT ARE OLD OR RUINED. THESE CLOTHES YOU CAN GET WET AND WASH THE DOG WITH.
FIRST YOU HAVE TO POUR WATER ON HIS BACK. THEN VERY CAREFULLY, ON HIS LITTLE HEAD, LIKE THIS: "SHHHH". THEN YOU APPLY THE SHAMPOO, DO A GOOD JOB OF IT. THEN YOU LATHER THE SHAMPOO VERY DELICATELY. TO BATHE A DOG YOU HAVE TO BE VERY DELICATE BECAUSE YOU COULD GET SOME SHAMPOO IN ITS EYES, OR WATER IN ITS EARS.

Sequence 4: If my dog were to get lost...
Lucia's drawings

Lucia tells us what she would do if her dog got lost. Her drawings illustrate her story.

LUCÍA VOICE OFF: **2:45:20**
IF MY DOG GOT LOST, WELL, I WOULD LOOK FOR HIM EVERYWHERE UNTIL I FOUND HIM. I WOULD SLEEP OUTSIDE IN THE STREET, I WOULDN'T MIND SLEEPING IN THE STREET. TO FIND SAMUEL, I'D SCREAM SAMUEL, SAMUEL, SAMUEL... SAMUEL!

Sequence 6: Drying and combing the dog.
Location: Lucia's front yard

Lucia finishes bathing the dog. She dries him up, combs him, and finally applies some lotion. Again she tells us step by step what she's doing.

WHAT I DON'T LIKE ABOUT SAMUEL IS THAT HE SHOOTS GAS ON TOP OF ME, THEN I GET ANGRY WITH SAMUEL. HIS "GASES" ARE SOUR, THEY SMELL SOUR. YUCK!!!!!!
