06.26	The French love to kiss... whenever they can!
06.30	They shower each other with (meaningless) false or airy kisses.
06.35	In Italy you kiss someone at least twice. Men also kiss each other when they greet one another.
06.43	However, you give a dignified kiss on the hand to an Austrian woman.
06.49	In England they don't kiss a lot. They prefer to shake hands.
