- 1'52 Wow! What a throw!
- 2'02 I wonder why he blew the foghorn? Perhaps it was to let the

 announces the stop in different languages.

- 2'28 But I'll stay here, because it's great travelling by boat.

 compass.
- 2'53 With that lever he can accelerate or slow down.

- 3'12 Everthing starts all over again...
- 3'15 ...the passengers are warned...the ropes are thrown.
 It's really interesting on a boat.
- 3'21 tying her up...
- 3'26 I could help him, I've got very strong teeth...
- 3'32 Excuse me... let me through I'm on the boat... and I'm
 getting off!
- 3'42 Up you get...ticket...I haven't paid...Closing.
- 3'53 Undo one part... then the other...
- 4'00 and away we go! It's a lovely sunny day on the lake... I love
 looking at the view and letting the wind ruffle my ears...
- 4'15 Oh dear, what's the ticket collector doing? He's checking
