9:00 Mandy found the climb too difficult, so she stopped, but Andrea kept going.

9:14 Rescuer John calls the information centre. He learns that due to bad weather the helicopter cannot take off, so they have to rescue Andrea on their own.

9:31 Andrea is frightened and cold.

9:42 Help is on its way!

9:53 Rescuers set off for the wall.

10:03 First they take care of safety. Into the firmly wedged pitons they place carabiners, through which the rope is passed, creating some kind of a fence.

10:25 They are getting closer.

10:37 Finally! The medic asks Andrea how she feels.

10:42 He looks at her footwear with disapproval. They move her to a safer place and cover her.

11:02 They give her a helmet.

11:06 The rescuers have to make sure she is well secured.

11:16 They position the rope.

11:21 The carabiner brake system is safely positioned into the anchor.

11:30 How many people have to risk their lives because of Andrea's recklessness!

11:42 Now they are all ready to descend.

11:48 Slowly they go down.

12:00 The rescuer carefully carries Andrea down the steep slope.

12:16 The clouds are beginning to disappear.

12:20 The weather is better now and there's a happy end to the rescue action episode...

12:24 ... due to the self-sacrifice of the mountain rescue service.
