ENTRY: 0001’51’11” – The berimbau has only one cord and it is made of barbwire. Later the cord is attached to both ends of the arch. It does take a lot of training to make this sound. – END: 0002’03’16”

ENTRY: 0002’46’23” – Capoeira is a traditional art from Brazil. It was created many, many years ago, in the time of slavery. Is it a game? It is a dance? Is it a fight? Exactly! It is everything together! – END: 0003’00’11”

ENTRY: 0003’02’01” – When taking Capoeira the acrobats and kicks mustn’t hit anyone. The winner is he who can play with the most...rhythm! – END: 0003’11’25”

ENTRY: 0003’15’06” – Everyone must pay close attention to the instructions passed on by their instructors. – END: 00003’19’18”
