The making of a kompang is rather tedious. Usually angšana tree or jade fruit tree is chosen in order for it to withstand pressure and vibrations. Cut pieces of wood are moulded into frame or which is called "baluh" of a kompang. They are dried before a piece of goatskin is attached to it and tightened using three pieces of metal plates. The almost finished kompang is dried under the sun before it is decorated with red cloth and gold-coloured nails.		English
