Documentary synopsis film named "Tamar wants to hear"

In a few months Tamar's life will be completely changed. She will start hearing sounds she has never heard before, a new range of sounds, richer and more colorful.

In three weeks from now Tamar will be operated and two Cochlear Implants will be implanted in both her ears, and hopefully, after a long period of recovery, her hearing Abilities will be regained.

Question: Are you afraid of the operation?

Tamar: Slightly, I fear spiders more

Question: What do you fear most?

Tamar: That it is going to hurt, and that I will hear with both my ears.

Tamar, a ten and a half years old charming, beautiful girl was born with a very serious hearing problem. The left ear was slightly working, while the right one wasn't at all. When she was 2 years old, her parents took her to the U S and there she had the Cochlear implantation. At that time very few children had this operation. Her problem was not completely solved, music was not heard properly, but it saved her from complete deafness.

Tamar: Do you see this picture?

I love it the most. It's me and dad before the operation.

Tamar has been growing up in a perfectly normal environment, getting along pretty well with her partly hearing ears. She has acquired her speaking abilities using her hearing capabilities (her mother worked with her), and she didn't have to learn to communicate using the signs language. Her friends got used to her. She wore a hearing device around her ear which was connected to a sound processor belted around her waist which transmitted the sounds to the implant. Everything was working quite well until a year and a half ago. The implant had gradually stopped functioning and that made her learning experience more and more difficult. She hears less and less, she cannot join her friends during breaks anymore. Today it is very difficult for her to talk to more than one person in the same time and she cannot talk on the phone as she used to do.

Her friends have started to laugh at her when she asks "what" all the time and she feels she is ignored by them most of the time. She has become more and more isolated in her silent world. Her parents have decided that time is short and that a new operation is inevitable. If Tamar is not having the operation in the near future she will become completely deaf, without her old friends and incapable to connect with the deaf people because she does not know their language! The doctor's advice is to have the operation during the summer holiday so she will have all the time she needed to recover.



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Tamar is afraid of the operation and she tries not to think too much about the future. Sometimes when she is very sad she takes off the hearing device and disconnects herself from her reality.

Tamar: Do you know what I hear when I take off the hearing device?

What?

Tamar: I hear the voice of a girl who is there inside me and wants to play with me.

One of Tamar's favorite place to play is the tree house . There she has fun with her sick dog and her cats ,with no worries connected with her hearing problems.

She built the house together with her father, her older sister Maayan and her grandmother. Tamar' grandparents own a carpentry studio and since she was 5 she likes to work with wood. Her room is full of various peaces of furniture she has made in the studio.

Tamar: In the carpentry studio you work in silence you do not need to speak at all

The operation Tamar is going to have is quite revolutionary and very complicated. They are going to change the old implant and in the same time implant an additional one in her other ear, through which she has never heard before. There are only few children in the world who have had this certain operation. In Israel there are two girls, twins, friends of Tamar's , and they are the ones who explain to Tamar about the operation . The twins told Tamar about the preparations before the operation which includes shaving Tamar's beautiful hair and the heavy headaches after the operation.

Tamar:You know what I love about myself? My long hair. My mother tells me that after the operation It will grow back as beautiful as before .

After the operation Tamar will not hear at all for awhile , and then during the long recovering weeks she will have to learn to use the two implants. If Tamar's operation will succeed her life will be changed completely. There is also a small chance that the implantation will succeed only partially, and then only one implant will function .The operation can be a failure too, and then Tamar will be deaf for the rest of her life.

The film will follow the little girl during the biggest drama of her life. Is she going to live a life of silence or a life of sound.

The Israeli documentary called "Tamar wants to hear"., tells the story of a 10 years old girl , Tamar, who was born partly deaf. This coming summer she will be operated and two special implants will be implanted in both her ears that are supposed to restore her hearing abilities. We will meet Tamar before the operation at her school , with her friends, at home with her parents and great parents, dealing with her hearing problem and waiting for the operation.

We will be with her in the operating room and we will visit her at home during the long days of her recovery.

The film will follow Tamar during the biggest drama of her life. Is she going to hear as a normal child , or is she going to be deaf for the rest of her life .

The director of the film Amir Gera, directed several documentaries, among them " A fold in the soul" , a film about the Israel writer , Isosel Bernstein, "Brother Daniel- the last Jew, which received the distinction at the Haifa international film festival 2001, a film named "Spish" , Changes 2004.

The producer, Adriana Segal-Witting, is IBA producer of youth and children programmes.

A special screening of all the documentaries will take place in Ponta Delgada on the 12 th of November 2005.

After the screening, each participant will have the opportunity to choose the films it wishes to broadcast in its own country.
