Majka, I can remember this, but
what happened during the War?

When you were little there were
grenades, a lot of things happened.

When a grenade exploded we were
telling you that was only a game.

We were running and playing
hide and seek so that you were

not afraid, not to cry.
We were making fun out of it.

I think the Channel is important
because a lot of people come

TC 00,05,32

and skate on the channel.

TC 00,05,36

I was on TV for the best story,
I received awards for music, math.

I wrote many poems and all that
was happening while there was

TC 00,05,45

a War here in Bosnia.

The War.

TC 00,05,55

My Mom takes me everywhere.
To school, gym and dance.

I wish I could fly high above
the ground like a bird,

but my poem says:

by myself with my friends.

My Dad would have let me,
but my Mum is waiting

in front of the door.

TC 00,08,46

Everything is like a bad dream.

School, Grammar, Math,
Physics, Chemistry...

I get a stomachache every time
they come and question me

and I don't know the answer.
They always say:
