02.16	I didn't want to swim any more.	(Jani looks after the boys)
02.34	<i>I became a coward, and cowards are never left in peace.</i>	<i>(Jani on the springboard at the pool → Jani miserable at the edge of the pool)</i>
03.13	Mikke!	(Mikke's back, he arrives to save Jani)
03.44	<i>Mikke has always been my brother. Because I don't have a real brother.</i>	<i>(Jani and Mikke enter the picture.)</i>
04.00	<i>That's why I didn't want him to go and study in another town and move from here.</i>	<i>(Jani walks away → Mikke is packing.)</i>
04.47	<i>The magic box. It would help you you do anything. Mikke got it long ago from his grandpa, who told him that the powers in the box can even open the door to the world. Mikke didn't need it any longer, and I got it.</i>	<i>(Jani examines the box → Jani looks after the car.</i>
05.35	You must always carry the box or it won't help	(Jani examines the box as the girl sings)
06.19	You must believe in it.	(Jani's fist clutches the box.)
07.24	It helps, but if you open it, the magic circle is broken.	(Jani comes from behind the corner and stops to examine the box.)

13.00	<i>But over time life resumed its earlier course. Except that it was no longer me who was being bullied.</i>	(Feet at school stairs → Jani sees the boys throwing the knapsack between them.)
13.39	<i>I wonder what would help?</i>	(Jani looks at the direction of the girl, worried.)
13.47	<i>Now I know!</i>	(Jani is delighted.)
13.55	<i>The magic box, of course. It contains good will. You must never open it, you just have to believe in it.</i>	(Jani puts a stone in the box and winds a rubber band around the box.)
