RTVE presents two new technology solutions in this session.

RTVE has developed SIGALSE (Sistema Inteligente de Gestión Automatizada de la Lengua de Signos Española). A new tool that allows deaf viewers to adjust the size, position and background of sign language interpreters. Allowing personalization to each viewer's requirements during RTVE programming.

RTVE has also developed a SIGAS subtitling system to adjust to last-minute schedule changes and live programming on its sports channel, Teledeporte, to ensure the subtitling runs effectively.
